- * Project WET training and complete book of award-winning activities
- * Extensive environmental education training with a rich set of other teaching activities and contact with a variety of resource professionals (potential speakers for classroom)
- * All-expenses-paid field trip for students to do water testing and learn about watershed issues. (Included in funding are bus transportation, substitute costs, and entire program. Funding covers up to 3 classes per teacher. If they teach more than three class, more classes per teacher may be covered if enough other teachers have fewer then 3 classes.)
- * Assistance if requested from program organizers.

Expectations of teachers:

- * Participate in all of the professional development training. One third to one half of it will be on 4 days in the summer of 2022, with additional meetings during the school year. None will be during the school day. Up to 70 hours. Dates will be decided with input from teachers.
 - * Lead your students in instruction related to some of the training. (You choose what fits your curriculum.) This includes bringing students on a field trip to do water testing.
 - * Engage students in a research or service project related to watersheds.
